#### FINDINGS TO BE DISCUSSED

10 CFR 5O.54(p)(2) states, "the licensee may make changes to the plans referenced in paragraph (p)(1) of this section, without prior Commission approval if the changes do not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the plan."

Contrary to the above, the licensee made changes to the Physical Security Plan which decrease the safeguards effectiveness without prior Commission approval in the following examples:

- The response requirement to engage an adversary to preclude penetration of a vital area was eliminated;
- 2. The phrase, \_\_to cause a significant release of radioactivity" was replaced with the phrase,"... would cause only a release in excess of 10 CFR Part 100 limit;"
- Search requirements for packages and materials were inappropriately extended to include service and repair vendors;
- 4. The uninterruptable power supply for the security radio system was eliminated and a manual action was substituted; and
- 5. The requirement for signal lines to be "supervised" was replaced by an undefined term.

Note: These apparent violations are subject to further review and may change.
