Reasons for Changes in Burden/Responses:

The proposed rulemaking, "Material Control and Accounting Amendments," would change the frequency for reporting on DOE/NRC Forms 472 and 472C to an annual, rather than the current semiannual, requirement. Only the two Category I facilities would continue to report annually .

Abstract:

The proposed rule, 10 CFR Parts 70, 72, and 74, "Material Control and Accounting Amendments" would reduce the frequency of reporting on NRC/DOE Form 742, "Material Balance Report" and DOE/NRC Form 742C, "Physical Inventory Listing," to an annual requirement for most licensees. Only two Category I licensees would be required to continue submitting semi-annual reports.
