SUBJECT: NATIONAL HISTORIC PRESERVATION ACT CONSULTATION  
PROCESS FOR THE PROPOSED PRIVATE FUEL STORAGE  
FACILITY WITH THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC  
PRESERVATION

On February 1, 2001, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff received an email from Ms. Carol Gleichman of the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (Council) discussing the timing of completion of the Memorandum of Agreement (Agreement) for the proposed Private Fuel Storage project on the Skull Valley Reservation. Ms. Gleichman stated that normally the Council recommends that a draft Agreement for the project be included in the Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS), ensuring that the public is informed about the proposed mitigation of adverse effects to historic properties and that it has an opportunity to comment to NRC on the proposed approach. Ms. Gleichman further advised once the comment period closed on the FEIS and during preparation of the Record of Decision (ROD), NRC should finalize the Agreement and have it signed by the consulting parties *before* the ROD is signed. Execution of the Agreement just before the ROD is issued ensures that the Council has a reasonable opportunity to comment on the project before a decision is reached.
