Remarks/Comments/Lessons Learned:

No decision reached today. This was a meeting to discuss the policy issues surrounding this type of case. This is the last of the first round of 61 OSREs and no previous OSRE's have been processed through the SDP. To anyone's knowledge, no enforcement actions has ever been taken as a result of an OSRE. On the other hand, the agency has taken enforcement action in the past two years for failing to demonstrate compliance with 73.55 during drills and OGCs advice is that such a violation is enforceable. Additionally the SDP was designed to evaluate drill response. Questions that need to be answered include:

1) Do we apply the SDP? If yes, do we modify the result? If no, do we

apply the traditional enforcement approach?
