Title: 10 CFR 50, "Releasing Part of a Power Reactor Site for Unrestricted Use Before Receiving Approval of the License Termination Plan"

Reasons for Changes in Burden/Responses:

Licensees will be able to submit a letter request or license amendment application to request a partial site release. All licensees will be required to maintain information on any changes in site boundaries.

Abstract:

NRC is amending Part 50 to establish a process for allowing power reactor licensees to release part of their site for unrestricted use before receiving approval of their License Termination Plan. A new section 50.83 would describe the criteria and regulatory framework for the partial site release. The new section would allow licensees to submit a letter request or, depending on radiological conditions, a license amendment application. The submittal would document the licensee's completion of required evaluations, surveys, recordkeeping, and reporting that would establish licensee compliance with health and safety considerations.
