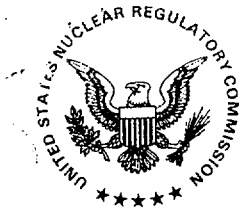
THREAT TO THE LIFE OF A TVA EMPLOYEE
