


On December 12, 2000, Consolidated Edison Co. of New York, Inc., Entergy Nuclear Indian Point 2, LLC, ("Entergy Nuclear IP-2") and Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. ("ENO") submitted a request to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) (Reference 1) for the transfer of the Indian Point Station Unit 1 Facility Operating License and the Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 2 Facility Operating License from Consolidated Edison Co. of New York, Inc. to Entergy Nuclear IP-2 and ENO.

On August 27, 2001 the NRC issued an Order approving the transfer of licenses from Consolidated Edison Co. of New York, to Entergy Nuclear IP-2 and ENO (Reference 2). Condition 5 of that Order requires, among other things, that the NRC be notified no later than 7 business days prior to the date of the closing of the license transfers. In accordance with Condition 5, please be advised that, subject to receipt of all required regulatory approvals, the parties to the proposed license transfers currently intend to close on the license transfers on Thursday, September 6, 2001.
