

Burros were brought here from North Africa by the Spanish in the 1500's as pack animals. Later miners used these rugged and sure-footed animals to carry water, grub, tools and pay dirt. Some escaped and multiplied in the wild. They are now numerous along the Lower Colorado River, and are protected by the Wild Horse and Burro Act of 1971.
