Fitness for Duty Program Six Month Performance Report

FITNESS FOR DUTY PROGRAM SUMMARY:

The Waterford 3 annual random testing rate is 50 percent. During this reporting period, approximately 24.9 percent of the population have been randomly tested. The rate of positive tests from random testing is 0.42 percent.

POSITIVE RESULTS:

As illustrated in the breakdown of confirmed positive tests for specific substances, there were four positive tests for marijuana during this reporting period. Of the substances tested for, marijuana was the drug of preference, accounting for 100 percent of the substances showing positive results. The Federal Regulation cut-off limit for marijuana is 100 ng/ml. Entergy, however, uses a more stringent cut-off criteria of 50 ng/ml for marijuana. During this reporting period all of the positive samples were greater than the Federal Regulation cut-off limit of 100 ng/ml.

MANAGEMENT ACTIONS:

Access was denied to the four short-term contractor personnel that tested positive. Three individuals tested positive during pre-access testing and one individual tested positive during random testing. Management was notified and the individuals' files were annotated to reflect the positive results and management's actions.

During this reporting period, six 'for-cause' collections were requested. Five collections were requested due to behavioral observations. One collection was requested due to an accident. All six 'for-cause' samples returned negative results.

EVENTS REPORTED TO THE NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION (NRC):

During this reporting period, there were no reportable violations of the fitness for duty program.

PROGRAM EVALUATION/AUDIT:

No programmatic problems were identified during this reporting period.
