Dear Mr. Christian:

The NRC staff reviewed your application dated December 11, 2000, to change the format and content of the Current Technical Specifications (CTS) to be consistent with NUREG-1431, "Standard Technical Specifications - Westinghouse Plants," Revision 1, and certain generic changes to the NUREG.

On the basis of our review of the proposed changes for the licensee-identified beyond scope issue, ITS Table 3.3.2-1 of Section 3.3.2, "Engineered Safety Feature Actuation System (ESFAS) Instrumentation," we request Virginia Electric and Power Company (VEPCO) provide the setpoint methodology used to change the CTS allowable values for each function along with the calculation of these allowable values. VEPCO is requested to provide a response to the staff within 30 days of the date of this letter.
