
## DOCKETED NUMBER PROPOSED RULE: PR-1,2,50,51,52,54,60,70,73,76&110 (66 FR 19610)

I am opposed to the NRC's proposed rule, "Changes to Adjudicatory Process," as published in the Federal Register on April 16, 2001, Vol. 66, pages 19609-19671.
