I, Michael J. Ruffatto, declare as follows:

- 1. I am the President of North American Power Group, Ltd. ("NAPG"), a privately held corporation with headquarters in Englewood, Colorado. I make this declaration in support of the Debtor's Motion For Order Approving Sale of Kern Facility Free and Clear of Liens. This declaration is based on my personal knowledge. If called as a witness, I could and would testify competently to the facts stated herein.
- 2. NAPG entered into an agreement with Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") dated August 24, 2000, as amended, to purchase PG&E's Kern power plant facility in Bakersfield, California. The sale was conditioned on, among other things, approval by the California Public Utilities Commission ("CPUC") pursuant to applicable provisions of the California Public Utilities Code.
- 3. I have reviewed and am familiar with Executive Order D-44-01, issued by Governor Davis on July 30, 2001 (the "Executive Order"). In my opinion, NAPG will be able to comply with the applicable requirements of the Executive Order.
- 4. As required by the Executive Order, NAPG intends to restore the Kern facility and return it to operation as a power generation facility.
- 5. As also required by the Executive Order, NAPG intends to enter into one or more contracts to sell power generated by the Kern facility and ancillary services to the California Department of Water Resources ("DWR") or any other credit-worthy California entity for distribution to California rate-payers on a cost-of-service basis for a term of not less than five years.
- 6. NAPG began negotiations with DWR some six months ago, but suspended those negotiations after the CPUC's April 2001 decision failed to approve the sale of the Kern facility to NAPG.
- 7. NAPG will resume negotiations with DWR and will begin negotiations with other entities that meet the Executive Order's requirements promptly within 5 business days after this court's order approving the sale of the Kern facility to NAPG. NAPG will use

its best efforts to negotiate and execute contract(s) with such entity or entities that meets the requirements of the Executive Order.
