Dear Mr. Grenier:

On August 8, 2001, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued a second request for additional information (RAI) to Transnuclear West Inc. (TN-West) regarding its Advanced NUHOMS® System. The RAI was issued due to concerns the staff identified with TN-West's analysis regarding the peak cladding temperature of fuel to be stored in the Advanced NUHOMS® System. On September 4, 2001, NRC received TN-West's response to the RAI.

On August 23, 2001, the staff notified TN-West that, based in part on TN-West's request to delay its response to the RAI until August 31, 2001, the staff would not commit to a new schedule until the RAI response has been received and the staff had completed its acceptance review. The staff has completed its acceptance review and has rescheduled the issuance of the draft safety evaluation report (SER) and certificate of compliance (CoC) to be no later than October 15, 2001.
