Assuming the Commission has no objection, the staff would inform the licensee that there is an apparent violation of 73.55 (a) with the details of the inspection finding/violation presented in an inspection report. The licensee would be afforded the opportunity to attend a regulatory conference to discuss the significance of the inspection finding and their views as to whether or not the finding constitutes a violation. If following that interaction, the staff concludes that a violation did occur, then a NOV would be prepared and issued.
