Reference: Your letter of June 9, 1967.

In response to a request from the Office of Safeguards and Materials Management, US AEC, Washington, D. C., we are elaborating on information contained in our letter to you, dated May 3, 1967.

Particularly in regard to Page 2, Paragraph 3, information is furnished that the "subsidiary ledger" cited therein is really a job ledger furnishing data for developing material unaccounted-for per individual contract. Primarily, we believe this to be of advantage to you. A modification of the "job ledger" permitting the establishment of internal balance areas by physical location serves the best interests of the AEC. The latter plan permits the localization of losses or gains.
