Dear Dr. McGann,

We noted that Ion Track Instruments still has two active exempt product registry certificates for which there is no corresponding exempt distribution license.

We ask that you submit to us a request for inactivation of the registry certificates NR-399-D-102-E and NR-399-D-103-E. For your information, by maintaining these as active certificates you will continue to be billed an annual fee from NRC.

In addition, please send us a product distribution report pursuant to 10 CFR 32.29(c) for the products distributed under the authorization of your last exempt distribution license for the periods from June 30, 1995, until the time of the license transfer. If none, please so state.

In order to inactivate your registry certificates we will need the following information for each model you have distributed pursuant to the two registration certificates referenced above:

- the total number of the products sold; the number of products still in use;
- the services (including source replacement and availability) the registration certificate holder will still provide to users of the product or the identification of an entity that will provide services;
- a commitment that the registration certificate holder will no longer commercially distribute the product; and,
- verification that no changes were made to the product since its initial registration or last amendment.

Please provide the product distribution report within 30 days and if possible your request for inactivation of your registry certificates.
