Dear Mr. Robarge:

This letter is concerning our August 3, 1999, letter which stated that we had received the information your attorney provided to the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) on June 3, 1999. The information related to your concern of employment discrimination at the Zion Nuclear Power Plant.

In our August 3, 1999, letter to you, we informed you that it was necessary for the NRC to release your identity during an investigation into your concern. We requested that you provide a response regarding whether you objected to the release of your identity within 30 days. We informed you that, if we did not hear from you within 30 days, we would assume that you objected to the release of your identity, and the NRC would not initiate an investigation into the matter. Our records show you received our August 3, 1999, letter at your home address on August 8, 1999. To date, you have not responded to our request. Therefore, the NRC has not initiated an investigation into your concern.

While the DOL was evaluating your discrimination case, we held this allegation file open pending the results of DOL's investigation. The Region III staff has reviewed the June 3, 1999, complaint that you filed with DOL, and the DOL investigation. Our reviews have not identified any enforceable items. On October 15, 1999, you voluntarily withdrew your DOL complaint to pursue this matter in federal court. We have closed this allegation since (1) we have not identified any enforceable issues and (2) you have withdrawn your complaint with DOL.
