By letter dated March 9, 2001, Duke Energy Corporation submitted a license amendment request to the Unit 2 Reactor Coolant System cold leg elbow tap flow coefficients. By telecon on September 12, 2001, the Staff requested the dates when the initial four calorimetric tests were performed as shown on Figure 2 of the March 9, 2001 letter. These dates were:

July 29, 1986
August 19, 1986
August 27, 1986
November 26, 1986

These dates also correspond to the initial four elbow tap differential pressure flow dates as shown on Figure 1 of the March 9, 2001 letter. The Unit 2 resistance temperature detector (RTD) bypass manifold was removed before cycle 2 start-up on March 7, 1988.




