**THIRD INTERVAL INSERVICE INSPECTION PROGRAM - NDE-9**


In a letter dated June 13, 2001 (Serial No. 01-328), Virginia Electric and Power Company (Dominion) submitted the inservice inspection (ISI) program for the third interval for North Anna Unit 2, including the associated relief requests.

In a September 12, 2001 telephone conference call with the NRC Staff, regarding Relief Request NDE-9, the application of Code case N-513 and the basis for the 18-month time limit on service water system repairs were discussed. These two items were resolved during the call. The NRC requested that the specific regulation applicable to the request for relief be identified on the docket.

The relief being requested in NDE-9 is made pursuant to 10 CFR 50.55a (3)(ii), which provides for proposed alternatives where the specified Code requirement would result in a hardship or unusual difficulty without a compensating increase in the level of quality and safety.
