Dear Mr. Keiser:

In a letter dated August 30, 1999, the Public Service Electric and Gas Company (now PSEG Nuclear LLC) submitted the Salem Generating Station Inservice Testing (IST) Program, for the Third IST Interval, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), Section 50.55a(f)(4)(ii), and 10 CFR 50.55a(f)(5)(i). Representatives of the NRC staff recently discussed the IST Program submittal in a phone call with Mr. Gabor Salamon on September 26, 2001. Based on this conversation, the staff understands that PSEG still requires NRC review of the three requests for relief contained in the August 30, 2001, letter. The staff further understands that PSEG intends to resubmit the Salem IST Program for the Third IST Interval, including associated relief requests, for NRC review. Therefore, the staff will close out your request dated August 30, 1999, and will review the resubmitted Salem IST Program, with its associated relief requests, upon receipt.
