Dear Mr. Hoyle:

These comments are submitted on behalf of the nuclear power industry by the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI)<sup>1</sup> in response to the *Federal Register* notice concerning the proposed rule, Changes to Nuclear Power Plant Security Requirements Associated with Containment Access Control (60 *Federal Register* 24803 - May 10, 1995).

We agree that the deletion of § 73.55(d)(8), separate access control to containment, is appropriate for the reasons delineated in the proposed rule change and compliment the NRC for taking this action. Significant savings can result from the elimination of this "unnecessary for safety" requirement.


