By letter dated August 14, 2000, you applied for approval of certain direct and indirect transfers of the Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station Operating License No. DPR-28. The direct and indirect license transfers would have occurred in connection with the transfer of the facility from Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Corporation to AmerGen Vermont, LLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of AmerGen Energy Company, LLC (AmerGen). Subsequently, by letter dated August 27, 2001, you withdrew the license transfer request.

The Commission has filed the enclosed Notice of Withdrawal of Request for Approval of Direct and Indirect License Transfers with the Office of the Federal Register for publication.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF DIRECT AND  
INDIRECT LICENSE TRANSFERS

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has permitted the withdrawal by AmerGen Vermont, LLC of its August 14, 2000, application for approval of certain proposed direct and indirect transfers of Facility Operating License No. DPR-28 for the Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station, located in Windham County, Vermont.

The approval of the proposed direct and indirect license transfers would have allowed the transfer of Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station under several scenarios from Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Corporation to AmerGen Vermont, LLC. The transfer of the facility to AmerGen Vermont, LLC will no longer occur.

The Commission had previously issued a Notice of Consideration of Approval of Proposed Direct and Indirect License Transfers published in the FEDERAL REGISTER on August 31, 2000 (65 FR 53037). However, by letter dated August 27, 2001, the applicant withdrew the request for approval.
