
To Whom it May Concern:

To whom it may concern:

Michelle Collins has asked me to write you a short note describing her training here at Old Dominion University with regards to radiation safety. Ms. Collins graduated from the program in Nuclear Medicine Technology (NMED) here at Old Dominion in 1992.

As part of the NMED curriculum Ms. Collins completed a full three credit course in Radiation Health (NMED 335 - 3 credits) which accounts for 45 contact hours specifically addressing radiation safety and radiation health. Radiation safety and radiation safety principles are also part of the Nuclear Instrumentation (NMED 332 - 4 credits) and Radiopharmacy (NMED 403 - 3 credits) coursework. Additionally all clinical coursework (NMED 440, 450, 460 - 26 credits) - 1312 hours includes practical instruction in radiation safety with regards to environmental monitoring, personnel dosimetry, radioactive material ordering, receiving, and waste disposal.

The Radiation Health course (NMED 335) is taught by the University Radiation Safety Officer and covers the following topics:

- Radioactive decay
- Radiation, including the biologic effects of radiation
- Specific Activity, half-life, decay constant
- Absorbed Dose, Dose equivalence
- ALARA concept, time, distance and shielding
- Exposure limits and guidelines, occupational exposure and exposure to the general public
- Instrumentation, theory and practical uses
- Federal Regulations (10CFR19, 20, 30, 33, 35, 71)
- Personnel Monitoring
- Spill procedures

I hope I have provided you with the information your office needs regarding Ms. Collins's education and training in radiation safety. Please contact me if you need any more information.
