Nuclear Management Company, LLC, (NMC), has received by Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) letter (Reference 1) the Order (Reference 2) providing NRC consent to the transfer of Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant (KNPP) operating license from Madison Gas & Electric Company (MG&E) to Wisconsin Public Service Corporation (WPSC), subject to the conditions described therein. The Order also approves a conforming amendment to KNPP Technical Specifications that the NRC will issue and make effective at the time the transfer is completed.

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NMC received an electronic facsimile of the Order on the date it was signed, September 20, 2001. Conditions imposed by the Order include, "After receipt of all required regulatory approvals of the transfer of MG&E's interest in KNPP to WPSC, WPSC or NMC shall inform the Director of the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, in writing, of such receipt within 5 business days, and of the date of the closing of the transfer no later than 7 business days prior to the date of the closing." As stipulated in our application dated April 30, 2001, as supplemented June 27 and August 3, 2001, requesting approval of the transfer of Facility Operating License No. DPR-43 for the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant (KNPP) to the extent held by Madison Gas & Electric Company (MG&E) to Wisconsin Public Service Corporation (WPSC) and approval of a conforming amendment pursuant to 10 CFR 50.80 and 10 CFR 50.90, the ownership transfer date was contingent upon installation of new steam generators at KNPP. The Steam Generator Replacement Outage commenced at 2352 on Sunday, September 23, 2001. The closing of business transactions was concluded at 0001 on Monday, September 24, 2001.

In accordance with conditions set forth by the Order, NMC hereby informs the Director of the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation that all regulatory approvals required for transfer of the KNPP operating license from MG&E to WPSC have been received. NMC says further that business transactions transferring KNPP ownership from MG&E to WPSC are closed. The KNPP operating license transfer is completed.

NMC respectfully requests that the NRC now issue and make effective the conforming amendment to KNPP Technical specifications as approved by the Order.
