Summary of Physical Security Plan (PSP) Revision 33 Changes
Clinton Power Station, Unit 1
Page 1 of 1

The following changes have been made via revision thirty-three (33) of the PSP. Implementation of these changes does not decrease the overall level of security at CPS.

- Section 1.4.2, "Personnel Training in Security Practice," Section 1.4.2.1 on page 1-2 is changed in order to remove the specific refresher training requirement from a minimum of one year; however, not to exceed thirteen months to in accordance with implementing procedures.
- Section 3.2, "Protected Area Portals," Section 3.2.1.5.1 is changed in order to add a clarifying sentence which states that the firearms detector control box is secured to restrict access to sensitivity level settings.

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
