Question

1. Confirm that the calculations performed to support the response to Generic Letter (GL) 96-06, "Assurance of Equipment Operability and Containment Integrity During Design Basis Accident Conditions," were reanalyzed for extended power uprate (EPU) conditions.

Response

The existing calculations for GL 96-06 concerning isolated piping sections potentially subject to overpressurization during a design basis accident were evaluated and revised as necessary for EPU conditions. Based on the evaluations, we confirmed the structural integrity of the containment pressure boundary post-EPU.
