I. <u>COMSECY-01-0027 - Duke Energy Corporation License Renewal Application for</u> <u>Catawba, Units 1 and 2, and McGuire, Units 1 and 2; Licensing Board Referral and</u> <u>Scheduling Order</u>

The Commission¹ approved an Order related to the license renewal application submitted by Duke Energy Corporation for the Catawba and McGuire nuclear power plants. The Order refers petitions to intervene and requests for hearing from the Nuclear Information & Resource Service and the Blue Ridge Environmental Defense League to the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel and provides schedules and procedural guidance for the conduct of any proceeding.
