LICENSE TO THE EXTENT HELD BY MADISON GAS & ELECTRIC TO
WISCONSIN PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATION (TAC NO. MB1877)

Dear Mr. Reddemann:

On September 27, 2001, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued Conforming Amendment No. 159 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-43 for the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant. The amendment approved a transfer of the facility operating license to the extent held by Madison Gas & Electric to Wisconsin Public Service Corporation.

Due to an administrative error, the paragraph 2.B.(2) of the facility operating license was left off the bottom of page 2. The paragraph inadvertently left off the bottom of page 2 of the facility operating license should read as follows:

- (2) Pursuant to the Act and 10 CFR Part 70, NMC to receive, possess, and use at any time special nuclear material as reactor fuel in accordance with the limitations for storage and amounts required for reactor operation, as described in the Final Safety Analysis Report as supplemented and amended;

Enclosed is the facility operating license with paragraph 2.B.(2) inserted correctly. We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused.
