Subject: Request to Change Address (and Name??)		
<p>Summary:</p> <p>The licensee sent in a request for an address change and in the address they stated their name as Bristol-Meyers Squibb (BMS), which is the parent company of E.R. Squibb & Sons, Inc.</p> <p>Mr. Vala stated that listing BMS as their name was a mistake. According to Mr. Vala, the licensee is still E.R. Squibb & Sons, Inc. I instructed Mr. Vala to send in a letter referencing the control numbers above that indicates that E.R. Squibb & Sons, Inc. is still the correct name of the licensee and that BMS is still the parent company. I also asked him to review their Parent Company Guarantee and any amendments thereto to assure that it accurately reflects the current status of the licensee and its facilities.</p> <p>For the -02 license, Mr. Vala also stated that he would include in his letter, a change in management contact and a change in RSC chairman. I instructed him to review NUREG-1556, Vol. 11 concerning the RSC chairman and to supply me with the criteria that will be used to select a chairman as opposed to a resume for a new chairman. I told him that Vol. 11 guidance permits the licensee to provide criteria for selecting a chair which permits licensees to change chairs without submitting an amendment request to the NRC. I stated that if he provides this criteria, I would remove the named chairman from the license.</p>
