<p>Summary:</p> <p>In the licensee's letter dated October 3, 2001, in response to my telephone deficiency call on 10/1/01, they stated "Health Physics personnel from the U.S. Army Communications-Electronics Command, Directorate for Safety, conducted a review of the Registration of Radioactive Sealed Sources and Devices for the LLDR. I informed Mr. Silber that this statement did not supply the information requested by the 10/1/01 telephone conversation. I told him that a review of the SSD registry was inadequate. Although the source is registered, the source-device combination that they are requesting is not in the SSD registry (i.e., the SSD sheet for the source does not list the device for the source-devices combination they are requesting). I instructed him to verify in his response to this telephone conversation that they have or would be reviewing the source device combination to assure safety and adequate engineering.</p>
