Re: ORDERS REGARDING APPROVAL OF THE TRANSFER OF LICENSE FOR SALEM AND HOPE CREEK GENERATING STATIONS, TO THE EXTENT HELD BY THE ATLANTIC CITY ELECTRIC COMPANY, TO PSEG NUCLEAR LLC, AND CONFORMING AMENDMENTS (Docket Nos, 50-272, 50-311 and 50-354)

Dear Mr. Collins:

On April 21, 2000, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued an Order approving the transfer of the interest held by the Atlantic City Electric Company ("ACE") in the Salem and Hope Creek Generating Station's operating license to PSEG Nuclear LLC. The Order also approved conforming license amendments, which will be issued and made effective at the time the transfers are completed. Subsequently, on December 19, 2000, the Commission issued a further Order extending the effectiveness of the earlier Order to December 31, 2001.

One of the conditions imposed by the April 21, 2000, Order to the Commission's approval of the transfer was that PSEG Nuclear LLC shall inform the Director, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, in writing, of the receipt of all required regulatory approvals and date of closing of the subject transfer no later than 7 business days before the date of the closing. This letter is intended to satisfy this condition by advising that all required regulatory approvals have been obtained and the closing of the transfer of the ACE interests in the Salem and Hope Creek operating license to PSEG Nuclear LLC is scheduled to take place on October 18, 2001.
