SUBJECT: MILLSTONE NUCLEAR POWER STATION, UNIT NO. 2 - CORRECTION TO  
AMENDMENT

By letter dated February 23, 1988, the Commission issued an Amendment to Facility Operating License No. DPR-65 for Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 2. The amendment modified the Technical Specifications as follows: (1) TS 6.5.3.9.b "Records," was modified to identify the Nuclear Review Board (NRB) minutes as an acceptable means to forward certain reports to the Senior Vice President, Nuclear Engineering and Operations, (2) a maximum of 12 hours of continuous, planned inoperability for liquid and gaseous effluent monitoring instrumentation was permitted, (3) inoperability of liquid and gaseous effluent monitoring instruments for the purpose of obtaining samples, was permitted, and (4) a period of 12 hours within which auxiliary sampling of radioactive gaseous effluent must be initiated if the established minimum number of effluent monitoring channels become inoperable, was established.

The Commission inadvertently assigned Amendment No. 125 to that action. The correct Amendment No. is 126.
