- Craig Woodard, Director, Pharmaceutical Research Institute Environmental Health & Safety, will replace Susan Voigt as the Chair of the Radiation Safety Committee (RSC). Our criteria for Chair of the RSC are:

 - Good leadership abilities
 - Authority and credibility by virtue of their position in the organization
 - The desire to serve as Chair of the RSC and the ability to devote the required resources to the position
