Gentlemen:

In response to your request dated October 10, 1975, the NRC staff has completed its review and has issued Amendment No. 26 with its attachment, Change No. 25 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-57 for the Edwin I. Hatch Nuclear Plant Unit 1.

This amendment revises sections in the Appendix B Environmental Technical Specifications for the referenced license. It authorizes you to revise the exposure period of thermoluminescent dosimeters (TLDs) used to measure external radiation in regimes II and III from eight and four weeks respectively to thirteen weeks. Additionally, the amendment clarifies the reporting of radioactive effluent releases from the facility in accordance with NRC Regulatory Guide 1.21.

The staff has evaluated the potential environmental impact of operating the plant in accordance with this amendment and has concluded that there will be no change in effluent types or total amounts nor an increase in power level, and will not result in any significant environmental impact. The staff has determined that the change in exposure periods for the TLDs should provide an improvement in the statistical analysis of data in these regimes. Having made this determination, the Commission has concluded, pursuant to 10 CFR 51.5(d)(4), that an environmental statement, negative declaration or environmental impact appraisal need not be prepared in connection with the issuance of this amendment.

This amendment does not involve new safety information of a type not considered by a previous Commission safety review of the facility. It does not involve a significant increase in the probability or consequences of an accident, does not involve a significant decrease in a safety margin, and therefore does not involve a significant hazards consideration. The Commission has further concluded that there is reasonable assurance that the health and safety of the public will not
