- Application requests authorization to operate units for an additional 20 years

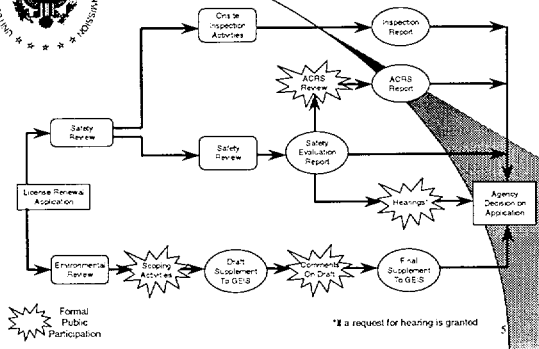


NRC's License Renewal Review

National Environmental Policy Act

- NEPA requires Federal agencies to use a systematic approach to consider environmental impacts
- An environmental impact statement (EIS) is required for major Federal actions significantly affecting the quality of the human environment
- Commission has determined that an EIS will be prepared for a license renewal action



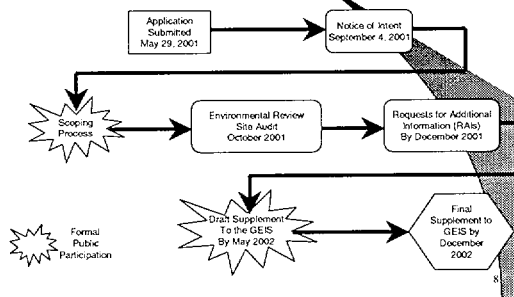
Decision Standard for Environmental Review

To determine whether or not the adverse environmental impacts of license renewal for North Anna, Units 1 and 2, are so great that preserving the option of license renewal for energy planning decisionmakers would be unreasonable.

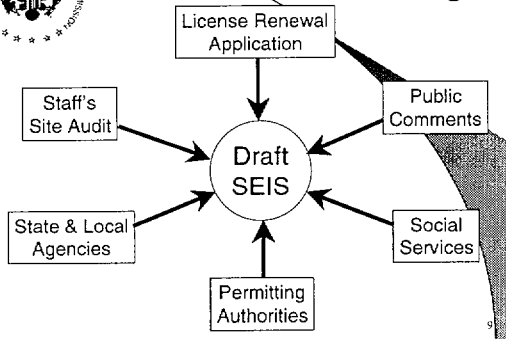
Environmental License Renewal Process


