



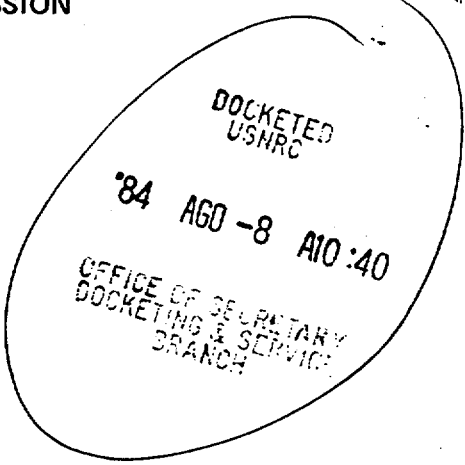

Dear Mr. Beckham:

By letter dated June 11, 1984, you withdrew your May 25, 1984, application for amendment to Facility Operating License No. DPR-57 for the Edwin I. Hatch Nuclear Plant, Unit No. 1. The requested amendment was for a one-time extension of the surveillance interval on containment spray testing.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 2.107, we have granted this withdrawal and have requested the Office of the Federal Register to publish the enclosed "Notice of Withdrawal of Application for Amendment to Facility Operating License".
