Dear Administrative Judges:

Pursuant to our discussion during the teleconference of September 5, 2001, I am providing information regarding the Staff's anticipated schedule for conducting the acceptance review and public notification of the revised decommissioning plan for Jefferson Proving Ground submitted by the Army in July 2001. The Staff is currently reviewing the July 2001 submission; however, the Army did not include its environmental review. The Army has informed the Staff that the environmental review should be submitted on October 31, 2001. Because the submittal is not, therefore, complete, the Staff cannot say at this time whether its acceptance review can be completed without the environmental review. If it can, and the submission is accepted, the Staff anticipates that a Federal Register notice should be published in January 2002. If, however, the Staff must await submission of the environmental review to complete its acceptance review, Federal Register notification would be delayed until April 2002, assuming that the submission is accepted and the environmental review is filed when expected.
