SUBJECT: HI-STORM 100 REVIEW SCHEDULE (TAC NO. L23344)

Dear Mr. Gutherman:

On July 3, 2001, Holtec International (Holtec) submitted a revised application in accordance with 10 CFR Part 72 for an amendment to Certificate of Compliance (CoC) No. 1014 for the HI-STORM 100 Cask System to permit design changes and allow the use of a 32 assembly fuel basket. To support the staff's evaluation of the amendment application, additional information was submitted by Holtec on August 13, August 17, October 5, October 12, and October 19, 2001.

The staff has reviewed all supplemental information and determined that its content is sufficient for the staff to complete its evaluation of the amendment application. However, the original amendment review schedule, issued by the staff, did not include the review of any supplemental information received from Holtec after September 2001. Therefore, delays incurred in evaluating the supplemental information received in October 2001, as requested by Holtec, will result in a delay in the staff issuing a draft CoC and safety evaluation report (SER) for rulemaking. The draft CoC and SER will now be issued for rulemaking no later than December 10, 2001, in lieu of November 21, 2001, as originally scheduled.
