**BROWNS FERRY NUCLEAR PLANT (BFN) - UNITS 1, 2, AND 3 - SUMMARY REPORT FOR JUNE 1, 1999, THROUGH APRIL 30, 2001**

The enclosures to this letter provide the BFN Summary Report (SR) for June 1, 1999 through April 30, 2001.

Enclosure 1 contains summaries which include brief descriptions of any changes, tests, and experiments with safety evaluations prepared for revisions to the Updated Final Safety Analysis Report, plant procedures (new and revised), special operating conditions, special tests, temporary alterations, and plant modifications that were field completed during this reporting period as required by 10 CFR 50.59(b)(2).

Since the last Summary Report, there have been two revisions to the Fire Protection Report (FPR) as a result of incorporating several Problem Evaluation Report corrective actions. Enclosure 2 contains the BFN FPR, Revision 16 which includes both revisions.

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
Enclosure 3 include copies of changes to the BFN Technical Specifications (TS) Bases in accordance with BFN TS Section 5.10, TS Bases Control Program. These changes have been incorporated for which prior NRC approval was not required.

Enclosure 4 contains Section 5.1, Technical Requirements (TRM) Control Program. These changes have been incorporated and did not require prior NRC approval.

Enclosure 5 contains summaries of docketed commitments that TVA has evaluated and revised using administrative controls that incorporate the Nuclear Energy Institute's (NEI) 99-04 "Guideline For Managing NRC Commitments" in accordance with 10 CFR 50.109(a)(7) through BFN Standard Programs and Processes (SPP)-3.3, entitled Managing NRC Commitments.
