XSNM02966            Taiwan Power Company (reload fuel for Kuosheng Units I and II)  
XSNM02967            Taiwan Power Company (reload fuel for Chinshan Units I and II)  
XSNM03033            Taiwan Power Company (reload fuel for Chinshan Units I and II)

We have been advised by GE that they were not awarded the contracts for material anticipated for export under XSNM02966 and XSNM02967. Regarding XSNM03033, two shipments were made which supported two additional reloads of fuel under an extension of a current contract which GE has with Taiwan Power Company, however, no additional exports will be made under this license.

Please reflect the termination of the three export licenses in your records.
