On Thursday, October 18, 2001, members of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held public environmental scoping meetings in Louisa, Virginia, in support of the staff's review of the application submitted by Virginia Electric and Power Company (Virginia Power, also referred to as Dominion) for renewal of the operating licenses for its North Anna Power Station, Units 1 and 2 (North Anna). Afternoon and evening sessions were held to allow maximum public participation. Formal presentations were made by Robert Prato and Andrew Kugler of the NRC staff. Attachment 1 is a corrected transcript for the afternoon meeting and Attachment 2 is a corrected transcript for the evening meeting. Attachment 3 is a copy of the presentation slides. Attachment 4 is a list of attendees for both the afternoon and evening sessions.
