Matters to be considered during the conference include (1) the progress of the parties in resolving legal issues including the definition of "protected activities" under 10 C.F.R. § 50.7, as well as the standard of proof in "dual motive" cases and the relevance of "remedy" case law on this subject, and whether briefing of these issues will be required; (2) discovery issues; (3) the need and appropriate schedule for dispositive motions, if warranted; (4) schedules for parties to provide the Licensing Board with lists of their proposed witnesses (including brief expositions of the subject matter of their testimony, if available) and documents

on which they propose to rely; (5) schedules for the evidentiary hearing; (6) possibilities of settlement of the proceeding; and (7) other appropriate matters.
