SUBJECT: CLARIFICATION OF BIOLOGICAL OPINION, ST. LUCIE PLANT, UNITS 1 AND 2  
(TAC NOS. MA6374 AND MA6375)

Dear Mr. Stall:

The National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) issued a revised Biological Opinion for the St. Lucie plant on May 4, 2001. The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) forwarded a copy to the Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) on May 18, 2001.

The current Opinion revises the Incidental Take Statement and modifies some of the Terms and Conditions of the previous Opinion. These changes need to be incorporated into Appendix B of the St. Lucie Plant Technical Specifications (TS).

Based upon discussions with your staff, clarification of some of the provisions of the revised Opinion was required before revising the TS. The NRC staff subsequently contacted NMFS to obtain the needed clarifications. The results of these discussions were enumerated in a June 8, 2001, letter from the NRC to NMFS. Enclosed is a copy of the October 8, 2001, response from NMFS to the NRC, which confirms the requested clarifications. This should provide FPL with the information needed to proceed with a revision to the St. Lucie TS.

In a telephone conversation on October 25, 2001, Mr. George Madden of your staff indicated that a proposed revision to the TS would be submitted by March 31, 2002.
