Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) I hereby request a copy of the following records that are in the possession of the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC):

1. The contract between the NRC and the National Commission on Radiation Protection and Measurements (NCRP) that requested the NCRP to examine the existing data on the ionizing radiation dose-response relationships, particularly with respect to consideration of whether the linear-no threshold hypothesis remains the appropriate method of extrapolating high dose, high dose rate exposure data to low dose, low dose rate effects and which resulted in the publication by the NCRP of NCRP Report No. 136, "Evaluation of the Linear-Nonthreshold Dose-Response Model for Ionizing Radiation."
2. All written or electronically generated communications including records of telephone conversations, emails, or meetings between the NRC and the NCRP or between or among the NRC and any other organization or individual or individuals, or between NRC and NCRP or other organization staff members or individual(s), or internally by staff members within the NRC or NCRP or any other organization with respect to that contract or its contents.

Copies of records may be transmitted to me in written form or may be emailed or may be sent on a disk in such form as may be read on my computer (PDF, MS Word, Word Perfect file); or, if available on a web site, the location of the web site and how to access the record will suffice. If sent by any method other than written, please notify me in writing that the copy was sent, when it was sent and in what form so that I will be sure to look for it electronically.
