<u>ORDER</u> (Setting Response Deadline and Telephone Conference)

Petitioner Nuclear Information and Resource Service (NIRS) has, since issuance of the Board's November 9, 2001, Memorandum and Order (Denying Request for Additional Extension of Time), filed two documents, dated November 9 and 12, 2001, in which it requests additional time for filing the petitioners' amended and supplemented petitions and contentions; protests the limitation of documents provided (or to be provided) by the Staff to the daily event reports for the four Duke plant units at issue in this proceeding, stating that it wishes to have access to daily event reports "generated by all operating pressurized water reactors including those of the same design, model and vintage as the Catawba and McGuire units"; and states that as of November 12, 2001, no daily event reports had been received.

With regard to these NIRS filings, the Board directs the Staff and Duke Energy Corporation to file electronic responses by <u>noon, Wednesday, November 14, 2001</u>, after which all participants shall appear for a telephone conference to discuss and resolve the issues raised by NIRS in its latest filings, at <u>4:00 p.m. Eastern time November 14, 2001</u>. In the interim, the petitioners are advised that they are to continue to prepare their amended and supplemented petitions and contentions under the assumption that the deadlines and dates specified in the

November 9 Memorandum and Order shall remain in effect.

Participants will be notified by e-mail of the number and passcode to use to be connected to the November 14 telephone conference.
