**Subject:** Spill Notification

Rio Algom Mining Corp.'s Smith Ranch Facility had a spill of production fluids during the morning of October 14, 2001. The spill originated from a broken pipeline in the SW SE Quarter of Section 26 of T36N R74W that ties Wellfield III to the CPP. The cause of the break is unknown at this time. Approximately 3,600 gallons of production fluid was spilled. Tests are being run to determine the concentration of uranium in the water. This notification is being made in order to comply with Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality's requirement to report all spills over 420 gallons. A written report will follow within seven (7) days.
