Dear Mr. Cain:

On October 22, 2001 at approximately 1030 in the evening we experienced an unplanned release of injection fluid at header house 3-2 in wellfield 3. Upon discovery of the leak the header house was immediately shut down. The estimated amount of injection fluid released was 62,400 gallons. The $\rm U_3O_8$ concentration of the injection fluid was approximately 2.7 ppm. Our investigation into the cause is incomplete at this time but initial indications point at a failed flange in the main pvc injection line feeding the header house. The Wyoming Department of Environmental Equality (WDEQ) has been notified and a complete report will follow within seven days.
