Dear Mr. Barron:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued Amendments 174 and 156 to the McGuire Nuclear Station, Units 1 and 2, Technical Specifications, dated April 24, 1997.

Due to an administrative oversight, Amendment No. 156 to McGuire Unit 2 stated that the amendment be "effective as of its date of issuance and shall be implemented within 30 days from the date of issuance." This is incorrect. The amendment should have read "The license amendment shall be effective upon replacement of the steam generators."

Please replace the current Amendment No. 156 for Unit 2 with the enclosed corrected page.

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
