This confirms our telephone authorization of June 18, 1982, for changes in the Technical Specifications for Sequoyah Units 1 and 2, as requested in your telecopy dated June 18, 1982, on containment sump level instrumentation and procedure requirements. For a period of thirty days commencing on June 18, 1982, the following changes are authorized:

- The logic for the automatic switchover of ECCS suction from the RMST to containment sump shall be defeated such that the switch can only be performed manually.
- 2. Operator procedures shall be revised for this period to insure that a manual switchover, if required, is performed properly. Region II concurrence is required for these procedures.

The amendments to the Technical Specifications that reflect the above authorized changes, our Safety Evaluation Report, and the Federal Register Notice, will be sent to you when completed.
