SUBJECT: SEQUOYAH NUCLEAR PLANT, UNITS 1 AND 2, TEMPORARY WAIVER OF COMPLIANCE FOR SURVEILLANCE REQUIREMENTS 4.8.1.1.2.d.2 AND 4.8.1.1..2.d.3 (TAC NOS. 71893, 71894)

By letter dated January 25, 1989, you requested a temporary waiver of compliance for surveillance requirements 4.8.1.1.2.d.2 and 4.8.1.1.2.d.3 for Sequoyah, Units 1 and 2. As discussed in a January 25, 1989 telephone conversation, an emergency technical specification (TS) change will be submitted on January 27, 1989. This TS change will revise the acceptance criteria for these surveillance requirements to reflect its dependence on the initial pretest voltage. This emergency TS change is required to preclude testing the remaining diesels and shutdown of Unit 1.

We have reviewed your evaluation and the justification provided in your submittal and find it acceptable. This letter confirms the verbal granting of a temporary waiver of compliance for the above change. This waiver will be in effect until January 30, 1989, while we complete the processing of your emergency change request.
